I will make an extended effort to help all campers feel comfortable and at ease. I will provide campers with the opportunity to be a vital part of a group that is positive, spiritually dynamic, socially comfortable, physically challenging, emotionally satisfying and mentally stimulating. I will treat people equally and with respect, no matter what race, religion or economic background they come from.

I will strive to maintain open lines of communication with people and if there is a problem with another person, I will approach that specific person and that person only. If the problem cannot be solved between us, I will go directly to the Camp Director for assistance. I agree that if conflicts are resolved in this manner, we will be able to prevent gossip and cliques, which will result in the promotion of group unity.
